

Tips for survival in a Bushfire - TOTAL FIRE BANS

A Total Fire Ban (TFB) is declared because of extreme weather conditions or when widespread fires are seriously stretching firefighting resources.

It is illegal to do anything that could or is likely to start a fire when a TFB is declared.

The ban includes all outdoor fires for the purpose of cooking or camping. It also includes incinerators, welding, grinding, soldering or gas cutting.

There have been some changes to the regulations that affect farmers so make sure you know that a TFB means for you.

- broadcast on ABC local radio and other media outlets.
