THE THREE BIN SYSTEM



GREEN WASTE BIN

A new lime green lid has been fitted to your old 240L general waste bin and is now your garden organics bin. This bin is collected fortnightly, see calendar below.

WHY HAVE WE INTRODUCED THE NEW THREE BIN SYSTEM

Separating garden waste, general waste and recyclables will help towards improving the communities waste output, with the intention of extending the lifespan of Wagin's refuse site.



NEW RED 140L GENERAL WASTE BIN

Your general waste should now be placed into your new 140L red bin, which has been delivered to all households. This bin is collected weekly.

WHY IS IT SMALLER

At the current rate that waste is accumulated, Wagin's Refuse site is estimated to only have a 20-year lifespan left. The Shire of Wagin and Great Southern Waste are trying to reduce the amount of general household waste output and help people recycle more to increase the Refuse site lifespan.



YELLOW RECYCLING BIN

Recycling bins were distributed in April 2008, but now we need to start using it more and recycle better. The contents of this bin are sent to Great Southern Waste Recycling Site to be processed. This bin is collected fortnightly, see calendar below.

WHY THE CHANGE TO THE NEW THREE BIN SYSTEM

This is a positive step in improving our waste management as a community. This will hopefully encourage residents to be more conscious about their waste, what goes in their bins, and where it goes.
